(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2023

To allow remedial works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Spenny Lane, Marden.

A closure is planned from 12th April 2023, with estimated completion by 13th April 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00635648164-02 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Spenny Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of April Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while remedial works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Claygate Road, Jarmons Lane, Collier Street, Kings Lane, Spenny Lane and vice versa.
